Items prohibited from Trash Transfer Station, accepted at Recycling Center:

- **Electronics**

Includes: TVs, VCRs, DVD players, computers and all accessories, fax machines, copiers, scanners, cell phones, and other hand held electronics.

- **Bear Spray**

- **Compressed Gas Cylinders**

- **Camping Propane Canisters**

- **Lithium Batteries**

- **Automotive Batteries**

- **Fluorescent Light Bulbs**

By appointment only, April - October. Go online to schedule. Anything toxic, flammable, corrosive, reactive, automotive fluids, oil based paint, poisons, etc.

Summer Hours



60% waste diversion from landfill by 2030 can be achieved with our community's help. Following the sorting policy stated, and recycling and composting as much as possible is significantly impactful. Thank you for your efforts with assisting Teton County on the Road to Zero Waste!

GENERAL POLICIES

- All loads must be sorted in compliance with the sorting policy manual.
- All loads entering the Trash Transfer Station are subject to inspection, sort fees, or rejection by Teton County personnel and contractors, Yellow Iron and Terra Firma Organics.
- Concrete cannot be unloaded into the Trash Building.
- All loads must be tarped. Un-tarped loads are subject to a fee.
- For all Demolition Loads, contractor must provide Asbestos testing and provide 48 hours' notice prior to disposal.

Yard Waste

- Leaves, branches, & shrubs
- Trees and stumps must be free of rocks and dirt.

Manure

- Manure, hay, straw (string must be removed)

Concrete/Masonry Block

- No larger than 2'x2'x2'
- Protruding steel, rebar and wood must be cut flush

Scrap Metal

- Electrical wires and conduit, metal fencing, plumbing fixtures, aluminum framed doors and windows (no glass), appliances (see refrigeration units below), etc.
- 55-gallon drums MUST have one end removed for inspection.
- Fuel storage tanks MUST be certified decommissioned.
- Snowmobiles, lawnmowers, snow blowers, motorcycles, etc. All fluids and batteries MUST be removed.

Refrigeration Units

- Includes refrigerators, freezers, and air conditioners.

Tires - Artificial football fields, molded products, running tracks, landscape mulch, and many other uses

Mattresses and Box springs - Recycled at Spring Back Utah

SORT POLICIES

Trash Transfer Station Wood Sorting Procedure



Clean Wood Pile

Dimensional lumber and Plywood only.

Metal 1/8 inch or smaller is okay. Neutral paint and stain is okay. Small amounts of dirt is okay



Dirty Wood Pile

OSB. Dark/brightly painted or stained wood. Small amounts of glue. Varnished hardwood furniture.



Trash Building

(must be cut down to 3-foot)

MDF. Particle board. Tar paper. Insulation. Styrofoam or Tyvek. Drywall. Large amounts of glue. Stickers or labels. Laminate. Trash.



****Pressure Treated Wood****

Dispose of pressure treated wood (including creosote & railroad ties) in the Trash Building. Cut down to 3-foot length.

TIPPING AND SORT FEES

The following materials **MUST** be separated and deposited in designated areas.
