Tracking Ongoing Teton County District Court Public Court Cases Generally

- All District Court Cases are assigned a case number.
- Knowing the case number will help you track case progress.
 - If you do not know the case number, and the case was filed in the last 90 days, please call us at 307-733-2533 or email us at codc@tetoncountywy.gov and provide the names of the parties and the type of action it is (civil, probate, criminal, etc.)
 - You may also review reports of the past 3 months of recent case filings at our office.
 - If you do not have a case number, you may either come to our office to search case records on our public terminal or you can request us to do a records search. Information about records searches is at <http://tetoncountywy.gov/1304/Case-Name-Searches>

Monitoring Teton County District Court Case Filing Activity and Upcoming Hearings

- Any member of the public may request a Records of Action (ROA) list of all public filings in a public case.
 - Requests for ROA lists should be emailed to codc@tetoncountywy.gov the case number included in the request.
 - Teton County District Court hearings are posted on a weekly basis, usually the Friday before the week that is posted.

Accessing Public Teton County District Court Case Documents

- Public case document can be accessed for no fee by visiting any WY District Court Clerk Office and using the Public Records Terminal which includes scans of case documents (Teton County has scans back to 2014). Our office is open M – F 8am to 5pm.
- Public case documents prior to 2014 that are still at our office can be viewed by requesting to view the physical file. Records prior to 2014 may be at WY Archives.
- Public records can also be requested to be printed/mailed or emailed to the requesting party. Document fees apply. More information is at <http://tetoncountywy.gov/1251/Case-Documents>.
