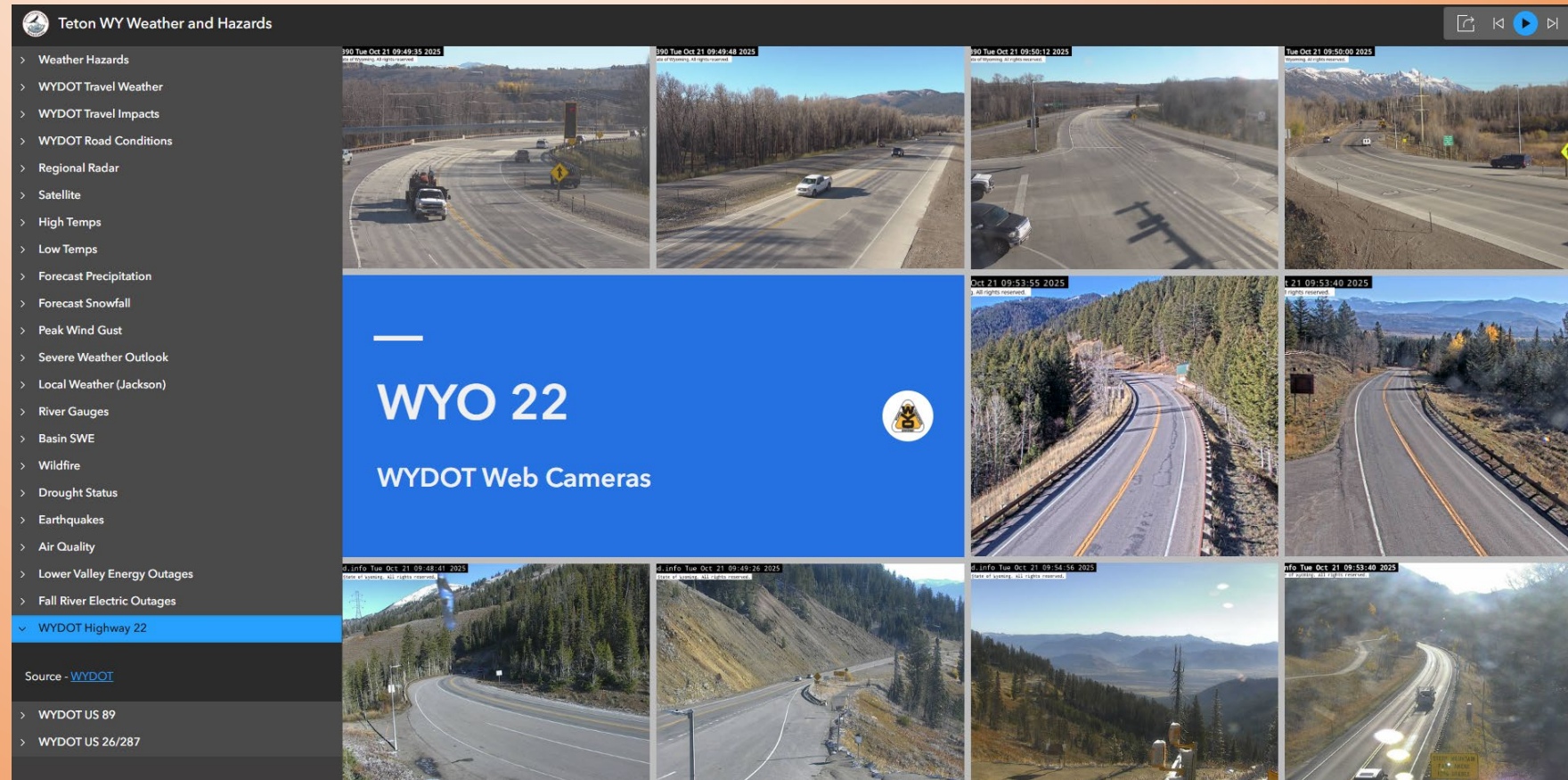

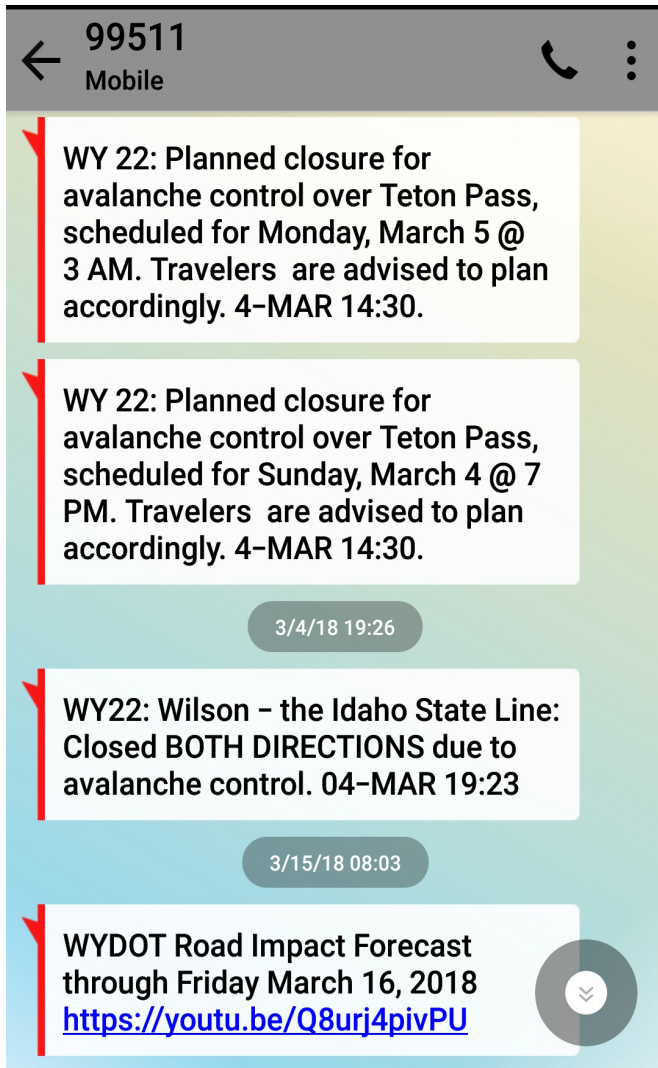

WY22: Weight limit of 60,000 GVW is in effect over Teton Pass between Jackson and the Idaho state line from milepost 7 to 17.

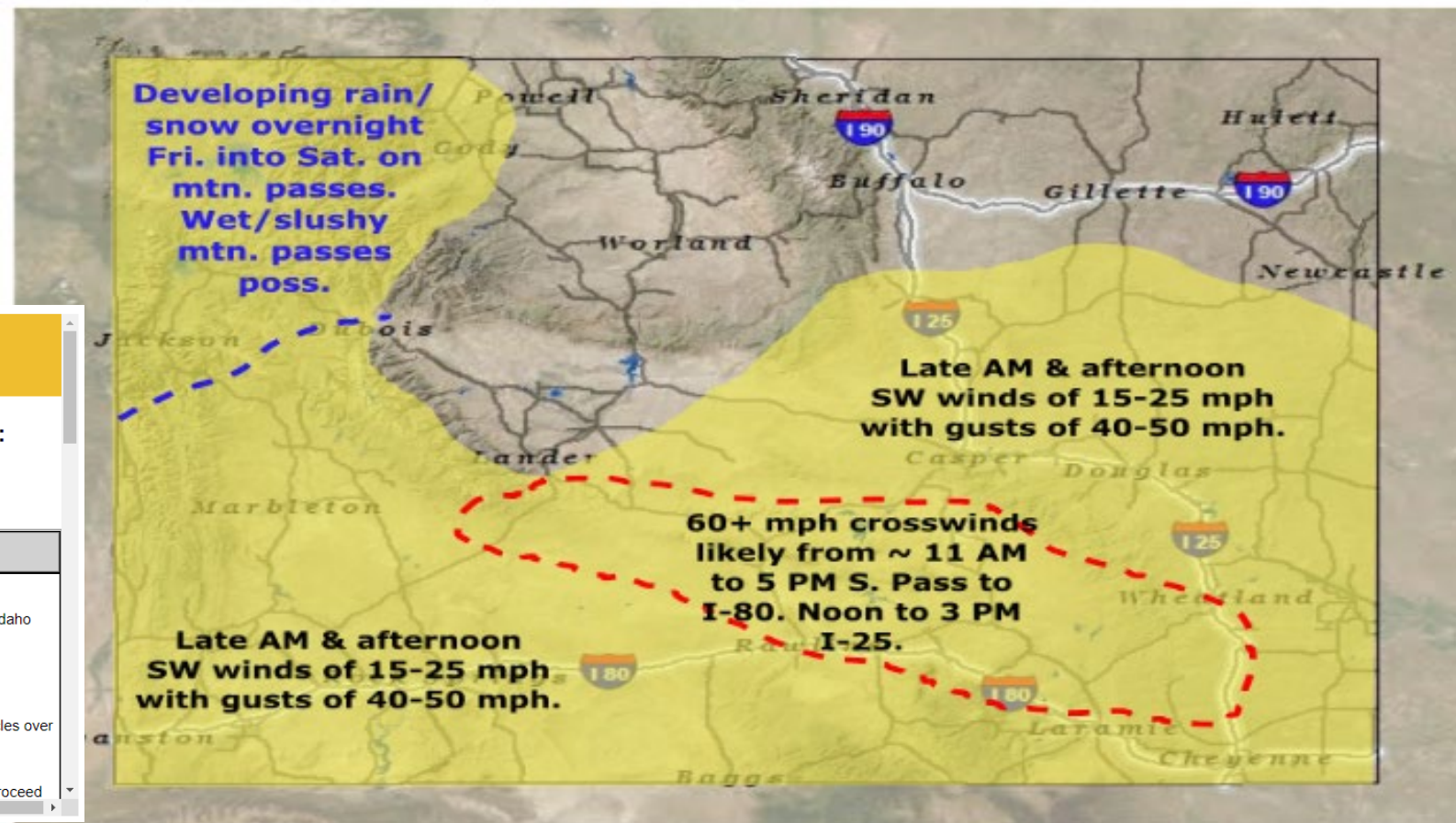
WY372: Open range near La Barge from milepost 12 to 48, Proceed with caution.

WY 390: Vehicle Restrictions in effect near Jackson at milepost 7.7. Narrow road. No vehicles over 23 ft. 4 in. length and over 8 ft. 4 in width. No Trailers allowed. Use alternate route.

US 30: Watch for falling rocks between Cokeville and Kemmerer from milepost 35 to 40, Proceed

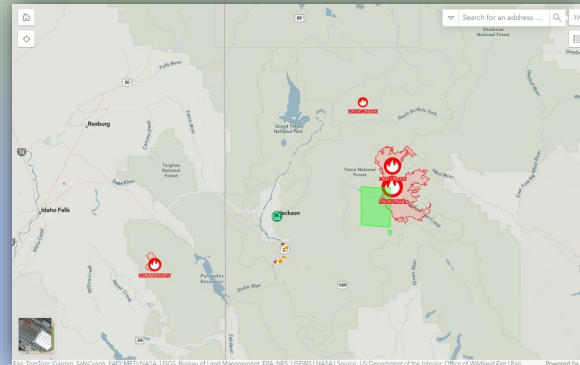

Quick Guide

This site is organized into views that provide relevant radar products and weather information for a common task or goal.

- **Radar station products**
This view provides specific radar products for a selected radar station and storm based alerts.
- **National radar mosaic**
This view combines radar station products into a single layer called a mosaic and storm based alerts.
- **Weather for a location**
This view is similar to a radar application on a phone that provides radar, current weather, alerts and the forecast for a location. Recommended for bookmarks.

Bookmarks

The URL will automatically update as you select the view and settings. You may bookmark the URL to return later to the same view with the selected settings. For example, if you select "Weather for a location," then select a location, the bookmark will return to your location on your next visit.

On mobile devices, you can save the bookmark as an easy-access icon similar to other apps. Please consult your device documentation for instructions.

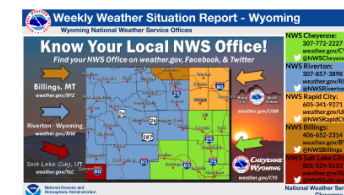
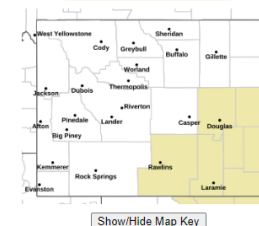

Snowstorms & Extreme Cold

Winter storms create a higher risk of car accidents, hypothermia, frostbite, carbon monoxide poisoning, and heart attacks from overexertion. Winter storms and blizzards can bring extreme cold, freezing rain, snow, ice, and high winds. A winter storm can:

- Last a few hours or several days;
- Knock out heat, power, and communication services; and
- Place older adults, young children, and sick individuals at greater risk.

IF YOU ARE UNDER A WINTER STORM WARNING, FIND SHELTER RIGHT AWAY

- Stay off roads.
- Stay indoors and dress warmly.
- Prepare for power outages.
- Use generators outside only and away from windows.

Avalanche

People caught in avalanches can die from suffocation, trauma, or hypothermia. On average, 28 people die in avalanches every winter in the United States. An avalanche is a large amount of snow moving quickly down a mountain, typically on slopes of 30–45 degrees. When an avalanche stops, the snow becomes solid, like concrete, and people are unable to dig out. Avalanches can:

- Be caused by people, new snow, and wind;
- Move at speeds of 60-80 MPH; and
- Peak during the period of December through March.

How to protect yourself from an avalanche

- Get training on how to recognize hazardous conditions and avalanche-prone locations.
- Learn how to properly use safety equipment.
